# TOUR ITINERARY

## Day 01: India – Tokyo

Today we will depart from India to Osaka via Tokyo by flight in the evening.

## Day 2: Welcome To Tokyo – Osaka - (By flight)

Welcome to Japan “The land of the rising Sun” – the country known for its traditional arts, oldest civilization, and embracing technology like no other country on the planet, on arrival at Osaka airport you will be met and transferred for lunch at an Indian restaurant. Later transfer to hotel and check inn to hotel post some rest later transfer to visit Osaka Castle (photo stop). Umeda Sky Building (entry). later in the evening transfer to Indian restaurant for dinner.

Overnight in Osaka.

## Day 3: Osaka –Kyoto & Nara tour

Today, proceed to Nara and visit the **Nara Deer Park**, the park is a home to hundreds of freely roaming deer also known as “Messengers of God” and the **Todaiji temple** where you can see the temple’s best-known relic “Daibutsu” - a colossal statue of the world’s largest gilded bronze Buddha, 15 meters in height. Later proceed to Kyoto & have lunch at an Indian restaurant. In Kyoto visit the **Kinkaku-ji Temple** - the heart of the temple



complex is the Golden Pavilion (kinka- ku), situated pictures quely in its garden at the edge of a lake, also visit the world famous **Arashiyama Bamboo Forest** where the thick green bamboo stalks seem to continue endlessly in every direction. Return back to Osaka & have dinner at an Indian restaurant Overnight in Osaka.

**Note : Prepare a small bag with 2 pair of clothes and necessary toiletries for 2 days)**

## Day 4: Osaka – Kobe - Hiroshima

After breakfast check out from hotel and transfer to Hiroshima enroute visit kobe city there you visit **Earthquake Museum**, later after Lunch at Indian restaurant, will be transferred to Hiroshima, in the evening arrival check inn to hotel, post some rest. In the evening proceed to an Indian restaurant for dinner. Overnight in Hiroshima  
(Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

## Day 5: Hiroshima – Tokyo

After breakfast check out from hotel and transfer to visit the **Hiroshima Peace Park and the Atomic Bomb Dome** (Genbaku Dome) which is a part of the **Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park and a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1996**, Later transfer for lunch at Indian restaurant proceed to visit **Miyajima island – Itsukushima Shrine-Floating Gate**, back to Hiroshima Bullet

**train** terminal to take an unforgettable bullet train ride from Hiroshima to Tokyo (approx. time 4 hrs) You will be travelling in one of the fastest bullet trains in Japan. On arrival you will be directly transferred for Indian restaurant for Dinner and in the evening transfer to hotel for check inn and overnight stay at hotel in Tokyo.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)



### Day 6: Tokyo

After breakfast transfer to visit **Ueno Park** famous for cherry blossom, later visit Jain later transfer to Asakusa visit the **Senso ji Temple** and spend some time at **Nakamise Dori**. Later, visit the **Tokyo Sky-tree**, a television broadcasting tower and land mark of Tokyo. With a height of 634 meters, it is the tallest structure in Japan and the second tallest in the world at the time of its completion. Later transfer to the **Shibuya Crossing**, one of the busiest crossing road. Later transfer to Indian restaurant for dinner. Overnight stay at Tokyo.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

### Day 7: Tokyo – with Mt. Fuji Excursion – Tokyo

After Breakfast you will be directly proceed to Hakone region to enjoy a cruise on the stunning **Lake Ashi**. Later, ride on the **Owakudani Ropeway** and see the rising volcanic fumes at the Owakudani boiling valley. Later after lunch, drive to the **5th station of Mt. Fuji** (subject to weather

conditions). Mt. Fuji is the highest mountain in Japan and often considered the symbol of the country. Later you will be transferred to Tokyo. Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight stay at hotel in Tokyo.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

### Day 8: Tokyo - Disneyland

After breakfast transfer for full day visit to Tokyo Disneyland spread on 115 acre theme park. It was opened in 1983. The park consists of seven themed lands, including Adventureland, Fantasyland, Tomorrowland and Toonland. It features iconic Disney rides like Space Mountain and offers seasonal decorations and parades. Evening back to Tokyo for dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight stay at hotel in Tokyo.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

### Day 9: Tokyo – Yokohama - Tokyo

After breakfast transfer from Tokyo to Yokohama to visit **Minato Mirai** and later transfer to visit China town after your visit proceed for lunch at Indian restaurant, back to Tokyo to visit the **Hei Shrine** famous for its **Red colour Torii gate**, Enjoy some moments at **Team Lab**. Later proceed to Odaiba, drive past the **Rainbow Bridge** and make a photo stop at the **Statue of Liberty**. Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight in Tokyo.

(Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

### Day10: Depart Tokyo – India

After Breakfast check out from hotel and you will be directly transferred to airport to board your flight to India. Return home with fond memories of your holiday

# The Dos and Don'ts of Packing for a Trip to Japan

## 【1】 Clothing

In spring, the weather can be mild, but it can still be cool, especially in March. Pack a combination of long-sleeved shirts, lightweight sweaters, and jackets for layering. Bring a mix of pants, jeans, and skirts or dresses. Don't forget a light jacket or raincoat, as spring can also bring occasional showers.

## 【2】 Power Adapters

Japan uses Type A and Type B electrical outlets, so bring a power adapter if your devices have different plug types. Additionally, check if your electronic devices are compatible with Japan's 100V electrical system.

## 【3】 Medications

If you take any prescription medications, ensure you have enough to last throughout your trip. It's wise to carry them in their original containers and bring a copy of the prescription as well. Additionally, consider packing a basic first-aid kit for minor illnesses or injuries.

## 【4】 Travel Essentials

Include a sturdy backpack or day bag for carrying your belongings, a reusable water bottle (tap water is safe to drink in Japan), a travel guidebook or maps, a language translation app or phrasebook, a portable charger for your electronic devices, and a universal travel adapter.

## 【5】 Toiletries:

Bring your preferred toiletries such as toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, soap, and any other personal care items you require. Consider travel-sized options to save space.

## 【6】 Personal Electronics:

Don't forget to pack your smartphone, camera, charger, and any other electronic devices you may need. Remember to bring a universal power adapter if your devices have different plug types.



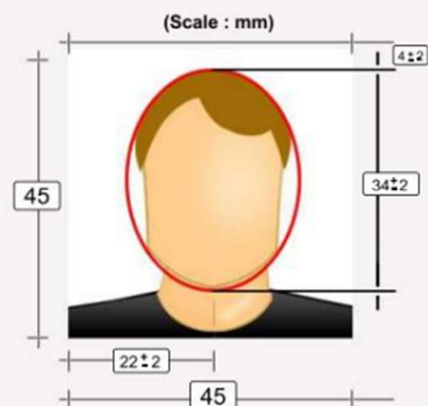
# JAPAN TOURIST VISA DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

- 2] Original Covering Letter from Applicant in Details
- 3] If working then Original Leave letter from Indian company with seal & signed with travel dates.
- 4] If working then salary slips for last 3 months.
- 5] Hotel Bookings
- 6] Tickets
- 7] Valid Passport 6 months from the date of travel. Applicants valid passport is required ( Handwritten passport is not allowed )
- 8] Personal financial papers like Personal bank statement for last 3 months with bank seal & signed & Income tax of last 3 years.
- 9] 2 recent 2inchX2inch photos, white background matt finish, 80 % face appearance
- 10] Day to Day Schedule
- 11] Covishield Vaccine Certificate (all 2 doses).

## Visa Photo Requirements

The Embassy / Government are very strict on the applicants photograph requirements. Your visa may be rejected if these requirements are not met.

- Not more than 6 months old
- 2 X 2 inch
- Colored, with plain white background
- Taken looking straight forward and face seen clearly
- On a good quality paper
