

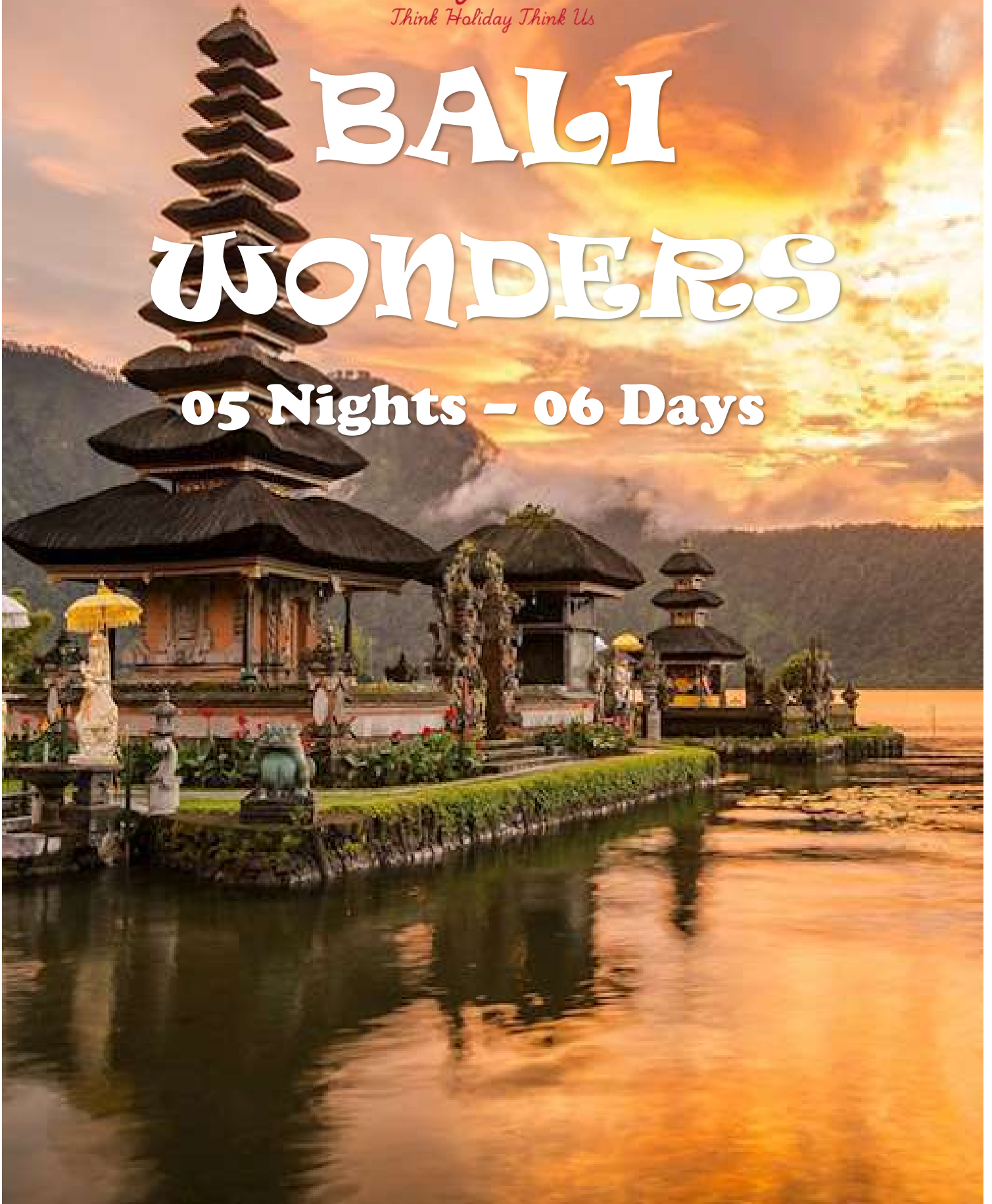

ABOUT BALI

One of the most popular tourist destinations in the world, Life in Bali is always related to “Tri Hita Karana” or a tripartite concept that include the spiritual relationship between human and God, and their environment. The rapid growth of development in tourism has had a big impact and influences to Bali tradition and lifestyle. Interestingly, Balinese culture is still as what it was, growing along with the of globalization. It is the Balinese civilization what makes the island different from other destination. It is world-renowned for its scenic rice terraces, fragrant cuisine, stunning beaches and a galore of culture and tradition. With its elaborate temples, endless coastline, some of the world's best coral reefs, waterfalls and retreats, Bali combines leisure and adventure impeccably.



Culture:

Bali is the only Hindu-majority province in Indonesia, with 86.9% of the population adhering to Balinese Hinduism. It is renowned for its highly developed arts, including traditional and modern dance, sculpture, painting, leather, metalworking, and music.

Temperature:

Being just 8 degrees south of the equator, Bali has a fairly even climate all year round. Average year-round temperature stands at around 30 °C (86 °F) with a humidity level of about 85%. Daytime temperatures at low elevations vary between 20 and 33 °C (68 and 91 °F), but the temperatures decrease significantly with increasing elevation.

Currency:

The rupiah is the official currency of Indonesia, issued and controlled by Bank Indonesia. Its name is derived from the Sanskrit word for silver, rupyakam

Conversion in INR: 1 Indonesian Rupiah = 0.0055 INR approx



Fun facts about Bali:

Many Balinese homes don't use house numbers. Instead, locals say things like “next to the big mango tree” or “behind the temple.” So if you're lost, just ask a friendly local — directions here are an art form!

There are over 20,000 temples on the island — that's roughly one temple for every 250 people! So wherever you go, you're never far from a prayer, a ceremony, or a sprinkle of holy water.

Balinese believe babies are pure and divine — so their feet shouldn't touch the ground for the first 105 days! Parents carry them everywhere until a special ceremony is held.

Highlights of the Tour - Bali Wonders

Monkey Forest (Ubud Sacred Monkey Sanctuary)

A lush tropical sanctuary home to hundreds of playful long-tailed macaques. Walk through ancient temple ruins surrounded by dense jungle, stone carvings, and sacred statues – a truly magical start to your Bali experience.

Ubud Palace

The royal palace of Ubud, known for its traditional Balinese architecture and cultural heritage. Enjoy a glimpse of Bali's royal history and catch an evening dance performance in this iconic setting.



Tegalalang Rice Terraces

Marvel at the stunning green terraces of Tegalalang, a UNESCO-recognized landscape showcasing Bali's ancient Subak irrigation system – perfect for scenic walks and photos.

Kintamani Volcano (Mount Batur Viewpoint)

Witness breathtaking views of Mount Batur and its surrounding lake. A panoramic paradise offering one of the most spectacular vistas in Bali's highlands.

Elephant Cave Temple (Goa Gajah)

An ancient 9th-century sanctuary famous for its mysterious cave entrance, intricate carvings, and bathing pools – a must-visit for culture and history lovers.



Tirta Empul Temple

A sacred water temple where locals and tourists alike take part in traditional purification rituals in holy spring pools – symbolizing spiritual cleansing and renewal.

Tegenungan Waterfall

One of Bali's most famous waterfalls, surrounded by lush greenery and tropical vibes. A great spot for swimming, photos, and enjoying nature's beauty.



Nusa Penida Island

A paradise island known for its dramatic cliffs, turquoise waters, and untouched beaches. A must-do day trip for adventure seekers and photographers.



Kelingking Beach

The iconic T-Rex-shaped cliff that has become Bali's most famous viewpoint. Enjoy jaw-dropping ocean views and, for the daring, descend the steep trail to the beach below.



Broken Beach

A natural wonder featuring a circular rock arch over the sea – a perfect spot for stunning photos of crashing waves and coastal beauty.

Angel's Billabong

A breathtaking natural infinity pool formed by the ocean's tides – its crystal-clear waters sparkle under the sunlight, offering an unforgettable sight.



Tanjung Bena Beach

Bali's adventure hub for **water sports** – enjoy jet skiing, banana boat rides, parasailing, and more. A fun-filled destination for thrill seekers and families alike.



TOUR ITINERARY - BALI (INDONESIA)

Day 01 Bali arrival

Arrival at Ngurah Rai Airport, Denpasar, Bali. Our representative will meet and welcoming you at the airport. Afterward, proceeding to the hotel for check inn. The day is free for leisure you can go to beach at your own, dinner and overnight stay at hotel.

Day 02: Full day Ubud – temple, rice terraces

After breakfast, proceed for a full-day excursion to **Ubud**, the cultural heart of Bali. Visit the **Sacred Monkey Forest Sanctuary**, home to playful monkeys in a lush jungle setting. Explore **Ubud Palace** and stroll through **Ubud Art Market** for souvenirs and handicrafts. Later visit the picturesque **Tegalalang Rice Terraces**, one of Bali's most iconic landscapes. **Overnight stay at hotel.**

(Breakfast + Lunch + Dinner)

Day 03: Kintamani Volcano, Temples & Waterfalls

After breakfast, we begin our scenic journey towards **Kintamani Highlands**, where you will witness the stunning view of **Mount Batur**, an active volcano, along with the serene **Lake Batur**. En route, we visit: **Goa Gajah (Elephant Cave Temple)**, a historical site with stone carvings. **Tirta Empul Temple**, famous for its holy spring water where locals perform purification rituals. **Tegenungan Waterfall**, surrounded by lush greenery, perfect for photos. Evening back to Kuta area for dinner at Indian restaurant later transfer to hotel for overnight stay at hotel.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

Day 04: Nusa Penida Island Adventure

Early breakfast and transfer to the harbor for a speedboat ride to **Nusa Penida Island** – Bali's most stunning natural paradise. Highlights of the day include: **Kelingking Beach**, with its iconic T-Rex shaped cliff. **Broken Beach**, a natural rock arch over the sea. **Angel's Billabong**, a natural infinity pool. Later in the evening transfer back to kuta area for dinner at Indian restaurant, post dinner transfer to hotel for overnight stay.

(Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

Day 05: Full Day Tanjung Benoa Beach

Today after breakfast, enjoy a fun-filled morning at **Tanjung Benoa Beach**, Enjoy live Indian lunch setup on the beach restaurant. Evening transfer back to Indian restaurant for dinner, transfer back to hotel for overnight stay at hotel.

Day 06: Departure from Bali

After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Depending on your flight schedule, you can enjoy some last-minute shopping at **local markets or Bali Collection Mall**. Transfer to the airport with beautiful memories of your Bali holiday.
